Quannah Chasinghorse-Potts

Quannah Chasinghorse-Potts is a Native American model and fourth-generation land protector for the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge. As a member of the International Gwich'in Youth Council and the Gwich'in Steering Committee, she spoke at the 2019 Alaska Federation of Natives Convention, where she urged members to reinstate a climate action leadership task force. Chasinghorse-Potts is an advocate for making the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge a permanent wilderness designation, which would protect it from oil development. She has spoken out about climate action and Indigenous rights at events and panels nationwide.

A member of the Gwich'in and Lakota Sioux tribes in her native Alaska, Chasinghorse-Potts began modeling in 2020 after appearing in Calvin Klein's *one future #ckone* youth campaign, which featured 11 everyday young Americans. She later signed with IMG Models and has appeared on the covers of *Vogue Mexico*, *Vogue Japan* and *V* magazine. She is known for her traditional face tattoos and makes a point of celebrating Indigenous fashion and promoting sustainable Indigenous brands.
